Edirne Before İstanbul: Capital City of the Ottoman Empire

The city of Edirne was the official Ottoman capital for at least half a century before the conquest of Constantinople. Yet the city has received relatively limited attention from historians. This talk will discuss Ottoman Edirne with two goals in mind. First, I suggest some reasons for Edirne's historiographical status and discuss why it remained in the shadow of Istanbul. Second, I begin to investigate early Ottoman Edirne with the assistance of Historical Geographic Information Systems (HGIS). In other terms, together with Ottoman and other sources, how can a contemporary data interpretation system help Ottoman historians to explore their own evidentiary materials in new and fruitful ways?
