## ***YILLIK: Annual of Istanbul Studies* Publishing Ethics and Peer Review Statement**

*YILLIK: Annual of Istanbul Studies* of the Istanbul Research Institute adheres to the highest standards of peer-reviewed and ethical publishing. Editors of the journal follow the principles laid out by the [Committee on Publication Ethics](#).

### **Authors**

Authors of articles published in *YILLIK: Annual of Istanbul Studies* should take public responsibility for the work they have put in the publication. Authors pledge that their articles have not been previously published in any language or format, and that their articles would be featured in *YILLIK: Annual of Istanbul Studies* as original works. Authors are responsible for submitting their work with full citation, in accordance with the Chicago Manual of Style's most recent edition and the style [guide](#) of the journal. After the submission, they must engage in the peer review process fully, responding to the feedback by the reviewers and the editors. Authors are responsible for clearing the necessary reproduction rights for any images, photos, figures, music, data, or other content credited to a third party. Any potential conflict of interest between the author and the subject matter must be disclosed with the submission of the article.

### **Editors**

Editors of *YILLIK: Annual of Istanbul Studies* evaluate manuscripts on the basis of their scholarly quality and relevance to the journal, not of authors' race, gender, sexual orientation, ethnicity, nationality, religion, political or institutional affiliation. However, the journal does not publish any manuscripts that reinforce discrimination based on these or any other identifications. Editors are responsible to ensure this, and to address any concerns with respect to discrimination. *YILLIK: Annual of Istanbul Studies* is an independent journal, without any institutional ties to governments, universities, or multinational publishing conglomerates; hence, decisions to publish are determined solely by the journal itself.

### **Peer review**

*YILLIK: Annual of Istanbul Studies* conducts a double-blind peer review process with two experts reviewing each manuscript. Articles submitted for publication in the journal are first evaluated by the editors of the journal, or by the editors of that specific issue. Articles deemed suitable by editors in terms of subject matter and quality are sent anonymously to two separate reviewers elected among the advisory board in accordance with their expertise, or again designated by the advisory board. Reports from the double blind reviewers are combined with the comments of the editors and sent back to the author. Depending on their quality and relevance, articles may be accepted or rejected, or the author may be asked to revise the work. Selected reviewers sign the review form, which informs the editors that they do not recognize the identity of the reviewed article's author and they do not have any conflict of interest, according to the best of their knowledge. After the initial feedback from reviewers and revisions by the author, if the two reviewers are in disagreement about the publication of the article, the editorial board gives the final decision. Other types of work, including editorials, Meclis papers, Cabinet essays, and reviews, are evaluated by the editorial board.

### **Confidentiality**

No information about a submitted manuscript is disclosed to anyone other than the author(s), reviewers, potential reviewers, and the members of the advisory board, as appropriate.

### **Addressing Unethical Behavior**

Authors and editors of *YILLIK: Annual of Istanbul Studies* must adhere to the publishing ethics outlined here. Plagiarism, falsification/fabrication of authorship or research, duplicate publication, and peer review manipulation would be regarded as severe cases of misconduct and would be dealt accordingly, including but not limited to retractions.
